



**CITY OF MANCHESTER, NEW HAMPSHIRE
NON-PARTISAN MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION
ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION
NOVEMBER 3, 2009**

Pursuant to R.S.A. 657:1, New Hampshire law requires that you vote in person at the polling place for your town or ward unless you declare one of the absences. I am entitled to vote by absentee ballot because (check one):

- a. I plan to be absent on the day of the election from the city, town, or unincorporated place in which I am registered.
- b. I cannot appear in public on Election Day because of observance of a religious commitment.
- c. I am unable to vote in person due to a disability.
- d. I cannot appear at any time during polling hours at my polling place because an employment obligation requires me to remain physically at work or to be in transit to or from work from the time the polls open until after the time the polls close.

R.S.A. 657:24. Any person who votes or attempts to vote using an absentee ballot who is not entitled to vote by absentee ballot shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
